Thank you for your interest in the Flint Regional Police Training Academy. You will find enclosed, information regarding the employment standards for Michigan Law Enforcement Officers, MCOLES Physical Fitness Pre-Enrollment test and test schedules. Each applicant must have passing scores on both the Reading and Writing pre-test, and Physical Fitness Pre-Enrollment test prior to entering an approved basic training academy. Recent changes allow participants to register for either the Physical Fitness Pre-Enrollment Testing, or the Written Testing on line, at www.mcoles.org

All candidates interested in admission must have a minimum of an Associates Degree in any discipline. Students who are enrolled at Mott Community College's Criminal Justice Program are offered fifteen credit hours upon successful completion of our academy training. Students interested in this option must first complete forty-seven credit hours within the Criminal Justice program at Mott. Please contact your academic advisor to see if you qualify.

Our next academy session is scheduled to start on March 7th, 2005, and will be held at the Flint Regional Police Training Academy building, 3420 St. John Street, Flint, Michigan. Training is conducted Monday through Friday with classes beginning promptly at 7:00 a.m. Each academy session is seventeen (17) weeks in duration. The academy features many additions to the required mandated curriculum some of these include:

Range 2000 Firearms Simulator
Preliminary Breath Test Operation (P.B.T.)
LEIN Certification Training
Radar Operation Certification
Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (Twenty Four Hours)

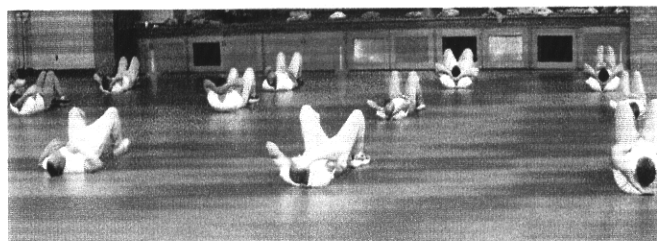
The cost for each candidate to attend the academy is \$3,600.00 payable upon acceptance. The enrollment charges are applied to tuition, books, ammunition and other equipment.
