070554 Chapter 18 (Taxation; Funds; Purchases)/Section 21.5 (Formal Contract Procedure)/Section 18.21.7 (Petty Expenditures Revolving Fund)/Section 18.21.10 (Emergency Purchases)

An ordinance to amend the Code of the City of Flint by amending Chapter 18 (Taxation; Funds; Purchases), Section 18, by the restating of Section 18-19 that provides the definition for "Proposals" and redefines the definition for "Contractual Services"; restating Section 18-21.5 (c)(1), Section 18-21.6; Section 18-21.7; the addition of a new section - Section 18-21.14; amending Section 18-21.10, Section 18-21.10(a)(1) and Section 18-21.10(b).

071729.1 Correction/Chapter 50/Zoning Change/STAT EMS, Inc./520 W. Third Street (Ward 5)

An ordinance to amend Chapter 50 of the Code of the City of Flint as requested by Marc G. Lund, STAT EMS, Inc. (PC-194) for a zoning change, specifically allowing Under 50-4, a zoning map amendment, to the property located at 520 W. Third Street, Parcel #40-13-284-021 and legally described as Stockton's West Addition from "C-2 Multi Family High Density Apartments to "D-3" Commercial Business District. 071730 Review/Ordinance/Downtown Development Authority/Parking

Councilwoman Sims would like the Flint City Council to revisit the ordinance recently adopted related to parking in the Downtown Development Authority District. The adoption of that ordinance has generated concerns from a number of individuals who park in the downtown area.
