- 080428** Tree Removal/1318 Cronk Avenue
- Referral by Councilperson Ananich to PARKS & RECREATION/MAYOR/ADM. He asks that the Forestry Division check a tree on the City property at this address for possible removal. Please provide a written response of actions taken and when.
- 080473** Kearsley Park/Standing Water/Erosion
- Referral by Councilperson Ananich to PARKS & RECREATION/MAYOR/ ADM. He asks that Administration address the following concerns within Kearsley Park: (1) along the northwest side of the park, in a parking lot near the playground, there is an accumulation of standing water - which becomes a haven for mosquitos every summer; and (2) on the same side, the erosion along the hill is so bad that it is now encroaching the area residents' properties. Please provide a written response to all Councilpersons detailing plans for fixing these problems within the park.
