On Tuesday, February 29, 2008 the City of Flint Department of Purchases and Supplies and the Flint Police Department will offer for sale to the highest bidder vehicles legally deemed abandoned without claim of ownership or forfeited to the Flint Police Department. All bidders and those wishing to enter the lot for viewing are required to obtain a bidder's number by making an advance \$120.00 refundable deposit with the Treasurer of the City of Flint. A minimum \$120.00 deposit will be required to hold vehicles until the final payment deadline. All final payments will be due by the close of business Thursday, February 21, 2008 in the City Treasurer's/Customer Service office located at City Hall. Deposits will be taken in advance by the Treasurer of the City of Flint at the Impound lot office after 9:00 AM. ALL BIDDERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO MAKE THE MINIMUM DEPOSIT AND BE ASSIGNED A BIDDER'S NUMBER IN ORDER TO BID DURING THE AUCTION. All bid receipts will be held under the successful bidder's number until the completion of the auction. The \$120.00 deposit receipt must be signed by the Purchasing Dept. representative if no bids are made to receive refund of deposit. Bidder numbers must be returned when receiving a refund or bill of sale for final payment. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS to these policies. Failing to abide by these guidelines may result in the forfeit of an individual's right to bid on any vehicles during this auction or at future auctions. Payment must be made by cash or certified check made payable to the Treasurer of the City of Flint. Personal checks will not be accepted. Checks from dealers, on business accounts only, may be accepted. Bills of Sale will be held for 10 days on all vehicles purchased by check. Bills of Sale will be made available by the City of Flint Police Department immediately after the completion of the auction on all vehicles sold without title and purchased by cash. The balance is to be paid no later than 5:00 PM Thursday, February 21, 2008 at the office of the City Treasurer/Customer Service or deposit will be forfeited. All balances must be paid in full before a Bill of Sale can be issued.

ALL MINIMUM BIDDING WILL BEGIN AT \$120.00

ALL VEHICLES MUST HAVE PROOF OF APPLICATION FOR NEW TITLE WITH THE MICHIGAN SECRETARY OF STATE COORESPONDING WITH THE NAME ON THE BILL OF SALE BEFORE BEING RELEASED. EVIDENCE OF SUCH MUST BE PROVIDED PRIOR TO 4PM ON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 22, 2008 OR ALL DEPOSITS WILL BE FORFEITED AND STORAGE FEES WILL BE ASSESSED.

ALL SALES ARE FINAL. Vehicles are sold "as is". There are no expressed or implied warranties or guarantees. There may be some deletions of specific vehicles prior to the auction and every effort will be made to identify those vehicles just prior to the start of the auction. The City of Flint reserves the right to postpone or withdraw the completion of any transaction if there are any irregularities in information that would otherwise delay or not allow for the sale of vehicles.

VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM LOT BY 4:00 PM, FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 22, 2008 OR THEY WILL BE CHARGED A DAILY STORAGE FEE. VEHICLES MAY BE DRIVEN OFF THE LOT UNDER THEIR OWN POWER OR TOWED BY LEGAL MEANS WITH THE USE OF A LICENSED TOW TRUCK, CAR DOLLIE, OR PROPERLY LICENSED TRAILER. THIS POLICY WILL ONLY APPLY FOR VEHICLES PURCHASED AT AUCTION AND NOT FOR THOSE RELEASED UNDER NORMAL IMPOUND.
