The MSHDA NSP2 Consortium Funding Agreement No.: NS2-2009-0049 for Flint NSP2 spells out the use of NSP2 funds for Flint; and

Funds are to be made available for the amount of \$35,970.00 from expense account 297-743.100-801.000.
