## RESOLUTION TO AMEND FY 2013 BUDGET TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR INELIGBLE SAFER GRANT EXPENSES

The Flint Fire Department desires to make amendments to the budget in order to fund overtime and fringes not covered by the SAFER grant. There is currently no budget for these ineligible expenses. Some of the necessary funding can be created by moving expense appropriations that were originally budgeted for six (6) employees in the department's general fund.
