Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

On August 12, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. the Department of Purchases and Supplies held a pre-bid meeting in regard to the Third Avenue Pumping Station modifications. All potential bidders were invited to the pre-bid meeting, which included a detailed review of the scope of services, question and answer session, as well as a walk through of the affected work area if requested. As a result only one bid was received.

The PLC and HMI electrical equipment is needed at the Third Ave pumping station to allow WPC to automate the station. The equipment is one of the key items to enable WPC to remotely monitor and control the equipment at the City's largest sewage pumping station from its Beecher Road location. This contract is for the both engineering and installation of all equipment. Cost savings will result by not having personnel on second and third shift.
