Background/Summary of Proposed Action: The Department of Parks & Recreation is responsible for the maintenance of all City owned trees, which are the trees between the street and the sidewalk as well as those located throughout 64 City owned parks. The City has always had a standby vendor for emergency tree services through a bid process. Due to staffing cuts in June, we lost our full time Forestry staff and were forced to use only contractors for tree trimmings and removals. J&M was the lowest responsive bidder from FY12. Due to the cutbacks, we are asking that J&M continue the tree trimming and removal services for the remainder of this fiscal year. Finally, J&M has agreed to keep the same pricing from last year for tree services.
