Agenda Item Title: Excavator Purchase

Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

During the City's FY09 fiscal year, the Purchasing Department solicited bids to lease an excavator for four (4) years. The request was originated from the City's Development Division and the equipment was used to demolish homes. The Development Division requested the lease because the funding that was received to demolish homes had a stipulation that the division could not purchase equipment. AIS Construction Equipment utilized Komatsu financial to lease said equipment and was the lowest bidder for this request. The City has been paying on the lease for the past 4 years.

The City of Flint's Water Service Center (WSC) is requesting to purchase said excavator by exercising the purchase option in the lease. WSC could use this equipment considering the depths of water and sewer excavations that are performed by this division. The Water Service Center is buying the unit as-is for a purchase price of \$68,415.00.
