Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

The purpose for which these resolutions are being presented is to approve an Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate for Extreme Precision Screw Products, Inc. on new personal property and to set a public hearing to provide an opportunity for interested parties to comment on the request.

Extreme Precision Screw Products is a swiss-type machine shop that specializes in military aerospace manufacturing. The company has invested \$181,955 in a Genos-300L MW precision lathe to be used in the manufacturing of parts for the aerospace industry. In particular, the lathe will be used to create engine components for military aircraft as well was parts for high-pressure power washing functions. . .
