The current amended grant agreement provides for the performance of site assessment activities funded through \$359,431 in grants. The initial grant was awarded by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality back in 2004 and has been increased by subsequent grant awards. The last grant increase in the amount of \$53,431 occurred in 2011.

The previously awarded grant funds have been used to perform site assessment activities for eligible brownfield projects such as, Diplomat Pharmacy, Kettering Fraternity House, Marion Hall, River Village Apartments, the Social Security Administration and Internal Revenue Service projects.

MDEQ has amended the grant agreement to extend the term until September 13, 2012.
