Background/Summary of Proposed Action: To enable the Traffic Engineering Division to fund the cost of maintenance and to pay for energy used by railroad grade crossings. CSX Transportation owns and maintains the traffic control devices at crossings of City of Flint roadways with their railroad right-of-way. In compliance with State of Michigan law, the railroad companies charge municipalities to maintain and energize these devices. This would provide funds to meet the City's obligations per that legislation.


