



Background/Summary of Proposed Action: To enable the Traffic Engineering Division to fund the cost of maintenance to, and to pay for energy used by railroad grade crossings. Grand Trunk Western Railroad owns and maintains the traffic control devices at crossings of City of Flint roadways with their railroad right-of-way. In compliance with State of Michigan law, the railroad companies charge municipalities to maintain and energize these devices. 
