Resolution to Cancel Spending Authority and Revenue Recognition in Various Homeless Prevention and Rapid Rehousing Program (HPRP) Accounts in the amount of \$122,679.78 for Reprogramming Availability

By the Emergency Manager:

Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) funds were previously reserved for projects and awarded to agencies to carry out programs and projects that benefit homeless and homeless at-risk individuals and families.

HPRP funds in the amount of \$122,679.78 have been identified as available to reprogram.

The HPRP funds available for reprogramming are in the following accounts:

297-746.442-801.000 (45,510.47), 297-746.360-801.000 (63,169.31), and 297-746.530-801.000 (14,000.00).

To reprogram the funds, spending authority and revenue recognition needs to be cancelled for expense and revenue accounts associated with the existing contracts.

It is resolved, that the appropriate City Officials are hereby authorized do all things necessary to cancel spending authority and revenue recognition in the expense and revenue accounts previously established and listed herein for reprogramming to another HPRP eligible activity.
