
**RESOLUTION**

On April 20, 2012, the Emergency Financial Manager authorized the Proper City Officials to enter into change order #2 to the contract with Citizen's Disposal, 2361 W. Grand Blanc Rd., Grand Blanc, MI for landfill disposal services in an amount not to exceed \$90,000 and a revised contract amount of \$546,329.00 as requested by the Sanitation Division; and


Various Departments are requesting to continue said services in an amount not to exceed \$255,000. Funding will come from the following account numbers: 202-443.201-801.000 (\$40,000), 226-528.200-801.000 (\$209,000), 590-550.202-930.000 (\$6,500); and

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Proper City Officials, upon the Emergency Manager's approval, are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to the contracts with Citizen's Disposal for landfill disposal services in an amount not to exceed \$225,000.00. 




