RESOLUTION TO MICHIGAN SWITCHGEAR FOR SWITCHGEAR MAINTENANCE SERVICES

On July 25, 2011, City Council authorized the Proper City Officials to enter into change orders #1 to a three year contract with Michigan Switchgear, 990 W. Beaver Rd., Auburn Hills, MI for the second year of a switchgear maintenance in the amount of \$40,000.00 as requested by the Utilities Department/Water Pollution Control Facilities and Water Plant; and


The Utilities Department is requesting said services for the third year as specified in the original proposal in an amount not to exceed \$28,000.00 for the FY13 fiscal year. Funding will come from account number: 590-550.202-930.000 (\$18,000.00), 591-545.201-930.000 (\$10,000.00); and

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Proper City Official, upon the Emergency Manager's approval, are hereby authorized to issue change order #2 to the contract with Michigan Switchgear for the final year of a three year contract for switchgear maintenance in an amount not to exceed \$18,000.00 for a revised contract amount of \$54,000.00 for the Water Pollution Control Facilities and \$10,000.00 for a revised contract amount of \$70,000 for the Water Plant. (Sewer Fund, Water Fund)


