RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR A \$50,000 GRANT TO THE RUTH MOTT FOUNDATION FOR GENERAL SUPPORT OF THE COMPREHENSIVE MASTER PLAN

The City of Flint, through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development received a \$1,570,233 Sustainable Communities Challenge Grant; and

The Community Challenge Award was granted to the City of Flint with a commitment to receive \$1,338,833 in matching funds. Local stakeholders have committed to matching the grant funds with \$668,038 of in-kind support and \$672,795 in cash resources; and


The Ruth Mott Foundation provided a Letter of Support for the Sustainable Communities Grant application committing \$150,000 to the project; and

The Ruth Mott Foundation has already provided a \$50,000 grant for the development of the Master Plan, one-third the amount pledged in the Letter of Support with the understanding that the City would apply again after expending these funds; and

The City of Flint plans to apply to the foundation during the current funding cycle requesting general support based on the cash match letter provided to continue to support the comprehensive planning process; and


