RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTIAL RELINQUISHMENT OF EASEMENT

By virtue of a resolution recorded at Liber 644, pages 359-360 Genesee County Records, in 1936 the City of Flint acquired the right to construct and maintain a subway through, along or under a portion of Harriet Street described (in part) as follows:

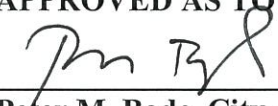
... also conveying the right of the City of Flint to construct and maintain a subway of sufficient size to be determined by the Council for the passage of pedestrians through, along or under said street whenever the same shall be determined by the common council to be a necessary public improvement; and

The City has determined that the reservation described above providing for the construction and maintenance of a subway is not necessary to the City, and may be abandoned and relinquished; and

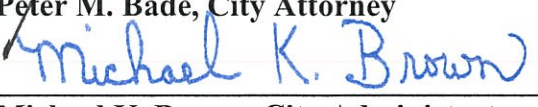
Relinquishment of the easement will promote development of the subject property; and

IT IS RESOLVED that a Partial Relinquishment of Easement shall be executed abandoning and forever relinquishing that part of the above described easement allowing for the construction of a subway under Harriet Street.

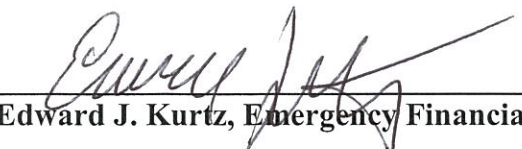
