**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A CITY OF FLINT
TITLE VI NON-DISCRIMINATION PLAN**

BY THE EMERGENCY FINANCIAL MANAGER:

As a recipient of both federal and state assistance, the City of Flint must provide access to individuals with limited ability to speak, write or understand the English language, must not restrict an individual from any advantage or privilege enjoyed by others receiving any service, financial aid or other benefit under its programs or projects, and may not subject individuals to criteria or methods of administration which cause an adverse impact because of their race, color or national origin; and

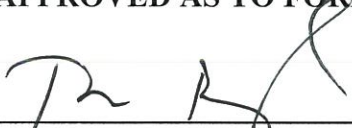
As the sub-recipient of federal transportation funds, the City of Flint must comply with federal and state laws, and related statutes, to ensure equal access and opportunity to all persons with respect to transportation services, facilities, activities, and programs without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, socio-economic status, or geographical location; and

The City of Flint has developed a Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan to assure that its federal and state funded services, programs and activities are offered, conducted and administered fairly.

IT IS RESOLVED, that the City of Flint Title VI Non-Discrimination Plan is adopted and shall be implemented as outlined, as the City will actively pursue the prevention of any Title VI deficiencies or violations and will take the necessary steps to ensure compliance.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that Derrick F. Jones, Purchasing Manager, will be designated Title VI Coordinator and will be responsible for initiating and monitoring Title VI activities and other required matters.
