Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

Rightway Remediation is currently contracted to complete absbestos abatement for properties scheduled for demolition. Funding is provided by the NSP3(Neighborhood Stabilization Program) funds through DCED(Dept of Community & Economic Development).

The demolition program is in need of additional services that will exceed the prior \$65,000.00 approved under contract 12-141.

Financial Implications: Asbestos abatement is required for demolition of structures being reimbursed by the Federal funds, without an asbestos abatement contractor program activities will cease and the department/City will be unable to expend the funds which are only available for a limited time period.
