

**Background/Summary of Proposed Action:**

Pursuant to Federal law, monies have been provided for the performance of certain improvements on public roads. Proposed road projects that will be paid with the use of Federal funds must be programmed with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for implementation with the use of Federal Funds under Federal programs.

Federal law requires that a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) be designated for each metropolitan urbanized area. The MPO is responsible for overseeing transportation projects and the processes that make them happen. The Genesee County Metropolitan Alliance along with staff from the Genesee County Metropolitan Planning Commission (GCMPC) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the region that includes the City of Flint. The Genesee County Metropolitan Alliance along with staff from the Genesee County Metropolitan Planning Commission (GCMPC) issued a call for projects to be submitted for Federal funding consideration under the FY2014-2017 Genesee County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The City of Flint Department of Transportation submitted ten applications in response to the call for projects (*proposed projects are identified on cover letter hereto attached*).

The Department of Infrastructure and Development, Transportation Division, is requesting that this resolution be adopted to attest the City's support for the applications submitted to the Genesee County Metropolitan Planning Commission for the FY2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) call for projects to secure funding for improvements to Federal aid eligible roads within the City of Flint's jurisdiction. The Transportation Division is also requesting that the City attest to its commitment to providing local funding for its share of project costs for projects selected for inclusion in the FY2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program.

**Financial Implications:** Millions of dollars in Federal funds may be secured for various road projects if the projects submitted are selected to be included in the TIP for FY2014-2017.

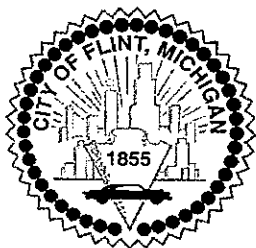
