IT IS RESOLVED, that the Proper City Officials , upon the Emergency Manager's approval, are hereby authorized to enter into a three year contract with Mike's Landscaping for mowing and trimming of parks, boulevards, and triangles in an amount not to exceed \$281,376.00. (Park/ Recreation Fund) \$93,792.00 pending adoption of the FY14 budget, \$93,792.00 pending adoption of the FY15 budget, \$62,528.00 pending adoption of the FY16 budget.





Agenda Item Title: Resolution Authorizing the City of Flint to enter into a contract for mowing services with Mike's Landcaping for mowing services from May FY13 - Oct FY16 for \$281,376.00.

Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

The City no longer employs staff for the Forestry division and is in need of mowing services for maintenance of various City properties and areas in the public right-of-way. The City has solicited bids for mowing services and has decided to award to the two vendors with the lowest responses out of the eleven submitted. Total contract dollar amounts were calculated based on the lowest price per location between the two lowest bidders. This resolution addresses the award to Mike's Landscaping.
