

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Proper City Officials, upon the Emergency Financial Manager's approval, are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Wade Trim for engineering and construction support services for biosolids loading facility in an amount not to exceed \$199,256.00. (Sewer Fund) \$91,850.00 for FY13 budget year and \$107,406.00 pending approval of the FY14 budget



Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

WPC is planning to build a Biosolids Loading Facility. Engineering support and assistance planning for the construction of said facility from qualified firms with significant experience as it relates to wastewater engineering is necessary. Wade-Trim/HRC, 555 South Saginaw Street, Suite 201 Flint, Michigan, 48502 ranked highest, with an average score of 83.5 out of 100 points, was selected. In addition to ranking highest, the vendor also had the lowest cost of \$199,256.00.

The Water Pollution Control Division had originally planned to include the cost of constructing a Biosolids Loading Facility in the 2014 fiscal year budget, but it has become a higher priority and engineering must begin immediately. Therefore, the funding will span over two fiscal years; \$91,850.00 for FY 2013 (Tasks 1 – 6) and \$107,406.00 (Tasks 7 – 9) for FY 2014.

Financial Implications:

Use funding from account 590-550.300-801.000, spanning over two years allocating \$91,850.00 for FY 2013 (Tasks 1 – 6) and \$107,406.00 (Tasks 7 – 9) for FY 2014.
