Genesee County voters have approved a tax to be used for the purpose of providing quality services to the aging population of Genesee County; and


The Genesee County Board of Commissioners has designated Senior Centers as the focal points of access to Senior Citizens for services and activities within communities; and

Genesee County requires approval of Operating Entities for Senior Centers to submit applications for the Senior Center 2014 Track One Program funds; and





Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

Genesee County voters have approved a tax to be used for the purpose of providing quality services to the aging population of Genesee County. The Genesee County Board of Commissioners has designated Senior Centers as the focal points of access to Senior Citizens for services and activities within communities. For 2014 the Genesee County Board of Commissioners has established a Track One Senior Citizen Application process, through which Hasselbring may request Track One funding not to exceed \$113,826 for Center expenditures during the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2014. Genesee County requires approval of Operating Entities for Senior Centers to submit Applications for the 2014 Track One Senior Citizen Center funds. The City intends to contract the operations of Hasselbring Senior Center to Loving Hands, Inc.
