PROPOSED REVISED BOUNDARIES

Carriage Town: The area bounded by a line beginning at the point created by the intersection of the center line of the Flint River and the easterly row line of N. Harrison Street, then north along the easterly N. Harrison Street row line until it intersects the easterly row line of N. Saginaw Street, then north along the N. Saginaw Street row line until it intersects the northerly row line of E. Fifth Avenue, then west along the E. Fifth Avenue row line until it intersects the northerly row line of W. Fifth Avenue; then west along the W. Fifth Avenue row until it intersects the westerly row line of N. Grand Traverse, then south along the North Grand Traverse row line until it intersects the center line of the Flint River, then east along the Flint River Center line to the point of beginning (POB).
