The Emergency Manager extended the moratorium on February 13, 2012, for an additional 180 days, and on July 27, 2012, for another 180 days, with the City Council most recently extending the moratorium on February 25, 2013, for an additional 180 days. This extended moratorium is due to expire August 3, 2013; and Additional time is required to afford the opportunity to review this matter and, to the extend needed, adopt appropriate regulations to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the general public, homes and businesses near such dispensaries and/or operations and patrons of such establishments.
