**RESOLUTION APPOINTING HEATHER V. BURNASH TO THE CARRIAGE TOWN

Pursuant to the Local Historic Districts Act, MCL 399.201 et seq (hereinafter the "Historic Districts Act"), the City established the Carriage Town Historic District Study Committee to study a proposed boundary change to the Carriage Town Historic District; and

The Historic Districts Act provides that a historic districts study committee must "contain a majority of persons who have a clearly demonstrated interest in or knowledge of historic preservation, and shall contain representation from one or more duly organized local historic preservation organizations." See MCL 399.203; and

Burnash, 803 Stevens St., Flint, MI 48502, is an attorney practicing law in Flint, Michigan; has extensive education concerning historical structures; serves on the Flint Historic District Commission; and possesses the knowledge and experience to serve on the historic district study committee.
