The Emergency Manager has determined that it would be advantageous for the City of Flint to extend the employment of appointed and executive staff; and

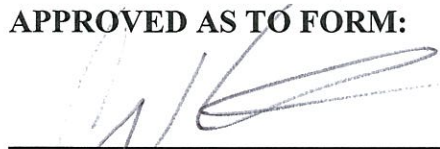
The duties of the appointed and executive staff shall be as required by the Emergency Manager on an at-will basis pursuant to authority granted the Emergency Manager by Public Act 436; and

Extended employment shall be at the will of the Emergency Manager until such time as the Emergency Manager determines that employment shall cease, or until such time as his authority as Emergency Manager terminates by operation of law, or up to and including January 4, 2015, at which time a review of staffing shall be done; and

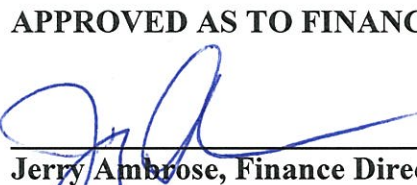
Compensation shall be at the rates indicated on the attached worksheet and shall be effective immediately upon adoption of this resolution; and

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Emergency Manager shall, on behalf of the City of Flint extend the employment of appointed and executive staff up to and including January 4, 2015, at which time a review of staffing shall be done. Compensation and benefits for appointed and executive staff members shall be pursuant to the worksheet attached hereto and made a part hereof, and shall be effective immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
