





Background/Summary of Proposed Action: A decision was made after the adoption of the FY14 budget to run the Water Plant from one month straight, by doing so; we have already exhausted our yearly Ferric Chloride. The Water Plant will need an additional \$20,000.00 for the remaining year to conduct its MDEQ required test runs.
