A public hearing was held and all residents and taxpayers of the City of Flint were afforded an opportunity to be heard thereon.

IT IS RESOLVED, That the Emergency Manager of the City of Flint hereby establishes the parcel of land situated within the City of Flint, County of Genesee and State of Michigan, to wit, and legally described on the Attachment, as a Commercial Rehabilitation District in accordance with Public Act 210 of 2005, as amended.
