Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

Metro Community Development is the administrator of the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) program as well as the lead agency for the Flint-Genesee County Continuum of Care. The City has determined that it would be cost effective to contract with Metro to provide fiduciary and administrative oversight of the City of Flint Emergency Solutions Grant program. Resolutions have already been adopted for previous year's administration and programmatic transition to Metro. City officials have also agreed to pay 80% of its 2013-14 annual administrative allocation to Metro for administration of the FY14 program. The City's administrative allocation for FY14 is \$19,584 – 80% is \$15,667.00. This resolution authorizes the transfer of funds to Metro Community Development through a contract which codifies the terms, allocations, sources of funding, and contract requirements and authorizes an administrative amount of \$15,667.00 to oversee the ESG grant.
