Background/Summary of Proposed Action:

In August 2013 the Department of Purchases and Supplies solicited bids for the installation of a replacement barscreen and compactor equipment at the WPC East Pumping Station (EPS). Sorensen Gross Construction was the lowest and most complete bidder of the said solicitations in the amount of \$395,000.00. However, due to the dimensions of the new equipment, the installation cannot continue without the construction of a roof hatch. Because this detail was not foreseen by neither the City nor the Contractor, a Change Order is necessary. The roof hatch will provide access for the Contractor in order to place the necessary barscreen equipment into the building. The barscreen equipment is needed for the purpose of screening debris out of the incoming wastewater. The debris is discharged into a roll off container and taken to the landfill. This is a critical part of the pumping station operation.
