RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATE CITY OF FLINT OFFICIALS TO ENTER INTO A REIMBURSABLE GRANT AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$13,961.97 WITH THE MICHIGAN SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ACCESS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES

BY THE EMERGENCY MANAGER:


The City of Flint, through the City Clerk's Office, was notified that a reimbursable grant from the Michigan Secretary of State's Office has been made available for the purpose of upgrading polling sites in the city under Title II, Section 261, of the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), CFDA 93.617, and

The City Clerk's Office is submitting a reimbursable grant application in the amount of \$13,961.97 to upgrade fifteen (15) polling sites to American for Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. It is anticipated that future reimbursable grants will become available in order to bring other City of Flint polling sites into compliance, as well.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the appropriate city officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to enter into the Voting Access for Individuals with Disabilities reimbursable grant agreement by and between the City of Flint (City Clerk's Office) and the Michigan Secretary of State's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that funds are budgeted under grant code SSOS15elect. Account No. 296-262.705-801.000 (Expenditures) and Account No. 296-262.705-539.000 (Revenues).
