Agenda Item Title: RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$100,000 FROM DUPONT FOR THE 2014 LEAD SAFE FOR KIDS SAKE GRANT.

Background/Summary of Proposed Action: The City of Flint was awarded a Lead Free for Kids Sake grant from DuPont in the amount of \$100,000.00. The City of Flint together with the Flint/Genesee Green & Healthy Homes Initiative will use these funds to improve local infrastructure and increase lead abatement and related healthy home unit interventions in the greater Flint area. \$8,000 of the grant will be for indirect cost for the Genesee County Health Department (GCHD) to provide program administrative services. \$25,000 will be for program management provided by GCHD for the proposal and includes contract development, program recruitment, unit assessment and scope of work development, contractor oversight, etc. The remaining \$67,000 will be used to provide in-home interventions and education in 45 homes to address lead and healthy homes issues identified in the assessment. Also USCM membership and conference costs for Mayor Dayne Walling are allowable expenses for the grant and will be paid/reimbursed through the grant funds.

Financial Implications: Lead Safe for Kids Sake funds will launch the first phase of a long-term strategy which will allow the City of Flint with the Flint/Genesee Green & Healthy Homes Initiative to expand and coordinate lead abatement, asthma control, integrated pest management and other healthy home services to more low-income housing Flint residents in the upcoming years. The proposed program is designed to function as a stand-alone program with the flexibility to leverage and merge with additional local or federal funding streams as they become available. No additional funds are required to be provided by the City of Flint.
