<u>Background/Summary of Proposed Action</u>: Each organization was advanced \$10,000.00 in order to operate because the County Millage is a reimbursable grant and they did not have the funds to expend on the front end of the transition period.

Throughout the year any ineligible amounts not reimbursed by the County were subtracted from the group's next payment. Also, the advance was to be repaid prior to the entities transitioning to their own separate Millage allocations. As of October 31, 2014 after calculating all eligible amounts reimbursed, ineligible amounts not reimbursed, and total repayments made of the advance, the Brennan group had repaid all of their advance and was not owed any funds, the Hasselbring group owed \$4,476.32 back to the City.

The City wishes to give back \$5,000.00 of the 'advance' to each center. This will result in a payment to both groups and reimbursement to the City of Flint Parks and Recreation Senior Citizen Centers (213) Fund account # 213-752.160-585.000 in the amount of \$4,476.32.
