**BY THE EMERGENCY MANAGER:**

The City of Flint has been awarded funding through the United States Department of Agriculture(USDA) Forestry Service Great Lakes Restoration Initiative(GLRI). The GLRI funds projects that protect and restore the Great Lakes ecosystem. The Chevy in the Hole project is intended to remediate contamination that threatens the Flint River, Saginaw River Water Shed, and ultimately Lake Huron.

The City applied for a modification to the existing grant that provides for phytoremediation activities at the Chevy in the Hole site. The modification extends the grant period to November 30, 2015, provides additional funding in the amount of \$400,000.00, and changes the number and species of trees to be planted. The Department of Public Works and Utilities wishes to accept this modification and recognize the funds in the 2014 budget.

**IT IS RESOLVED;** appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things necessary to accept USDA GLRI Grant Amendment #A2 to grant# 13-DG-11420004-020 in the amount of \$400,000.00, to comply with the grant terms, and to appropriate funds in the necessary revenue and expenditure accounts beginning with 296-390.391.



**Background/Summary of Proposed Action:** This is an amendment to the second award from the USDA Forestry Service for phyto-remediation activities at the Chevy in the Hole site. This project has received three award amounts:

1. \$375,000.00 (Initial Grant Award)
2. \$250,000.00 (Subsequent Grant Award)
3. \$400,000.00 (Grant Modification)

The following three modifications have been made to the grant of \$250,000.00:

1. The grant period has been extended an additional six months from May 30, 2015 to November 30, 2015.
2. The grant award has been increased by \$400,000.00; from \$250,000.00 to \$650,000.00.
3. The required plantings have been adjusted by species and number count. The number of new trees will be 600, not 1,200.

**Financial Implications:** Financial implications relate to properly expending and requesting reimbursement for the funds. Budgeted expenditures in the amount of \$400,000.00 have the potential to impact the General Fund if not timely, properly expended and/or reimbursed. Accounts in the 296 fund, dept/activity 690.391 should be used.






