On May 15, 2013, the Emergency Manager authorized the Proper City Officials to enter into a contract #13-024 with Environmental Consulting and Technology (ECT), 2200 Commonwealth Blvd., Suite 300, Ann Arbor, MI for engineering services for "Chevy in the Hole" Phytoremediation Project in an amount not to exceed \$245,000.00; and


The Department of Purchases and Supplies has solicited a proposal for additional engineering services for the said project based on an approved modification of the existing grant number 13-DG-11420004-020 from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) until November 30, 2015; and


ECT was the lowest responsive bidder from the solicitation for specified requirements and received the highest ratings for their proposal. Funding for said services will come from the following account: 296-690.391-801.000; and

IT IS RESOLVED, that the Proper City Officials, upon the Emergency Manager's approval, are hereby authorized to issue change order #1 to contract #13-024 with ECT for additional engineering services for the "Chevy in the Hole" Phytoremediation Project in amount not to exceed \$397,000.00 for a total revised contractual amount of \$642,000.00 (USDA GLRI Grant Modification #A2 Grant # 13-DG-11420004-020. (USDA Forest Service Grant Fund)

Background/Summary of Proposed Action: The City received an amendment to the second award from the USDA Forestry Service for phyto-remediation activities at the Chevy in the Hole site. This project has received three award amounts:

1. \$375,000.00 (Initial Grant Award)
2. \$250,000.00 (Subsequent Grant Award)
3. \$400,000.00 (Grant Modification)

The following three modifications have been made to the grant of \$250,000.00:

1. The grant period has been extended an additional six months from May 30, 2015 to November 30, 2015.
2. The grant award has been increased by \$400,000.00; from \$250,000.00 to \$650,000.00.
3. The required plantings have been adjusted by species and number count. The number of new trees will be 600, not 1,200.

Financial Implications: Accounts in the 296 fund, dept/activity 690.391 should be used.


