SPECIAL FLINT CITY COUNCIL ELECTRONIC PUBLIC MEETING

On December 22, 2020 Public Act 267 of 1976 was amended through Senate Bill 1246 extending the electronic meetings with no reason through March 31, 2021. The act also allows after March 31, 2021 electronic meetings may be held if a local state of emergency was declared. On March 23, 2020, the Flint City Council extended Mayor Neeley's declaration of emergency indefinitely due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Due to the increased spike in the number of COVID-19 cases in Michigan, and the new Omicron variant that is spreading throughout the United States, this meeting will be held electronically.
