Adopt-A-Park Program

The Keep Genesee County Beautiful (KGCB) Adopt-A-Park program encourages volunteer groups to formally participate in making a City of Flint park an attractive, clean and safe place to meet and play.

KGCB encourages neighborhood groups to step up and become involved in their local park. Adopters are required to pick up litter in the park at least once a week and to place trash containers in the park. Many park adopters decide to do more, including painting and minor repair to equipment in the park. All park improvement and cleaning materials are provided by KGCB or City of Flint at no cost.

When a Park Adopter group joins the program they are expected to:

- Attend an orientation
- Participate in training sessions on park planning and park safety
- Hold regular park cleanups and weekly maintenance and assume responsibility for the general cleanliness and condition of the park
- Seek additional volunteers who are physically able to regularly walk through the entire park to pick up litter

After successfully adopting a park for one year, Park Adopters may be selected to move up to the Park Tender level. In the past tender groups have received up to \$25,000 per year in grant funding for major park improvements. The tender program has limited spacing and monetary awards vary based on funding availability.


