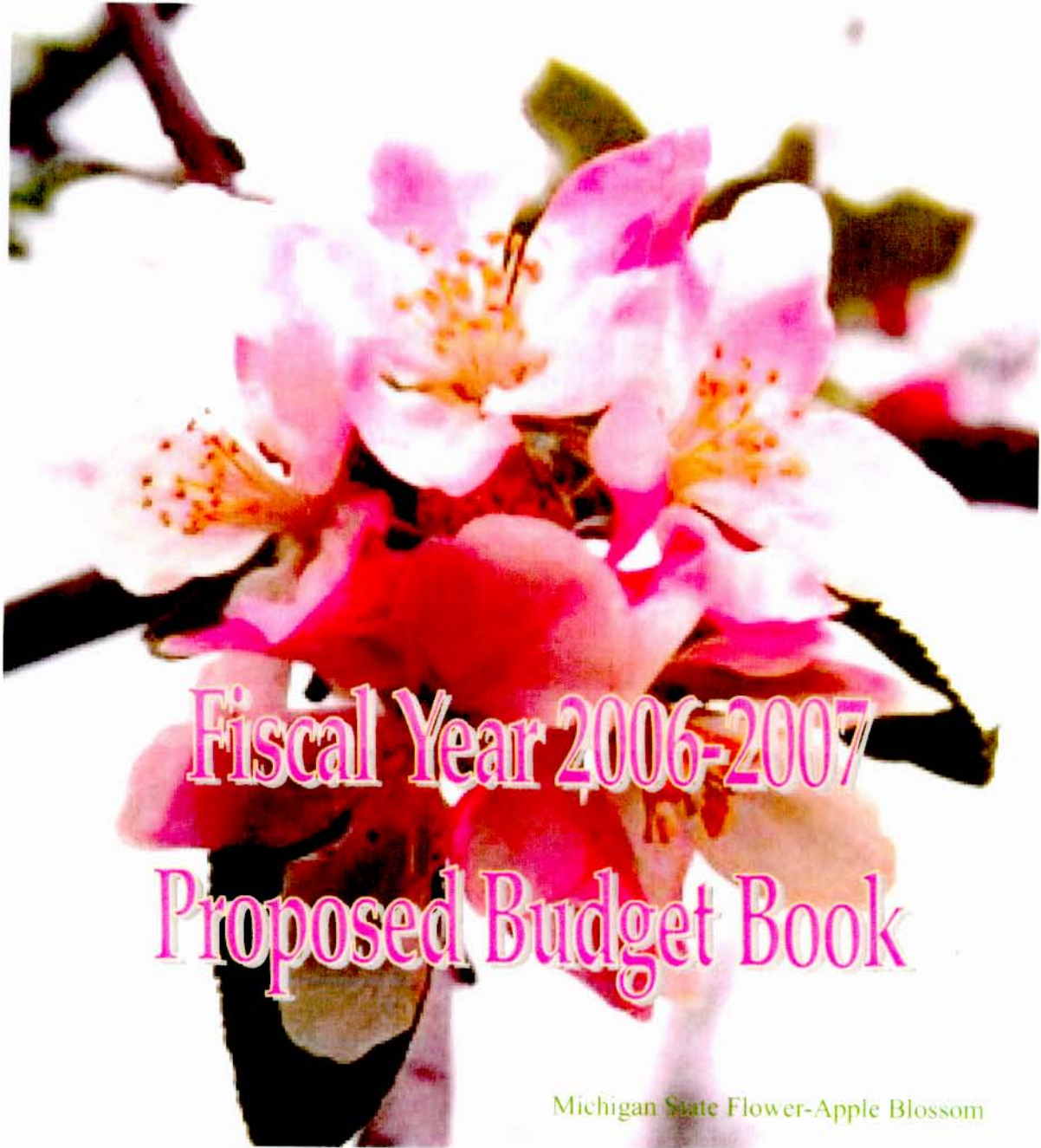

Dear President Buchanan and Members of the Flint City Council:

Attached you will find the fiscal year 2006-2007 Proposed Budget for the City of Flint. As you know, the City continues to face a lack of revenue growth caused primarily by a continued decline in the City's tax revenue base. The proposed budget was designed to continue effective and responsible government, while maximizing the City's limited resources. To that end, the following priorities were determined to be most important to the attainment of service goals and objectives in the forthcoming fiscal year. Additionally, the \$6.1 million surplus from fiscal year 2005 has been maintained in this proposed budget to facilitate the settlement of all union contracts not settled in fiscal year 2006. Flexibility and alternatives are also provided to counteract the uncertainty of revenues from the automotive industry. Through maintenance of a fiscally responsible surplus, the City will avoid public safety layoffs and interruption of taxpayer services until alternative revenue sources can be realized. Only through monitoring of actual revenue collections can sound financial management and service delivery decisions be made. With that, I present to you a brief summary of highlights and an overview of the 2006-2007 Proposed Budget for the City of Flint.

Let me begin with local and major streets. The supplemental road program has requested funding to continue its aggressive street-paving program. During fiscal year 2005-2006, approximately 46 lane miles were paved. The Sidewalk Replacement Program, previously funded with federal monies, has requested \$400,000.00 to repair and/or replace sidewalks in targeted CDBG areas. In fiscal year 2006-2007, the City will utilize a new technique to aid in snow removal. The technique uses calcium chloride to thaw the snow, which stays put and does not roll away when applied. Also, the calcium flakes and/or nuggets pass through the ice melt spreader and other equipment easily. By using this new technique, taxpayer dollars will be saved and our streets will be safer during the winter months.

Various departments – Human Relations and Law, for example – have also requested funding to provide additional services to the citizenry of Flint. The Human Relations Commission has requested funding to provide sensitive and timely assistance to residences with utility and other housing issues; training workshops; and, seminars regarding fair housing awareness and support. Through effective leadership and management, the Department of Law has requested funding below fiscal year 2003-

2004 levels. The low funding request will not compromise professional services or staffing. Also, if grant funding is acquired, the Department of Law will launch the new Flint City Attorney's Community Justice Project in fiscal year 2006-2007. The Department of Law shall continue its focus on revenue restoration activities, responsible government operations, and management of all the City's legal matters.

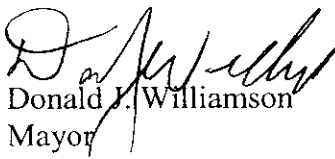
Savings will allow the funding for the Customer Service, Income Tax, and Treasury Divisions to be reduced by \$207,940.00 due to successful leadership, restructuring of operating procedures, and the installation of new tax software. In fiscal year 2006-2007, customers will be able to use the new internet and credit card bill payment system. The Building Inspection Fund continues to require subsidy from the General Fund – for fiscal year 2006-2007 an additional \$395,144.00 is required. As you may recall, during fiscal year 2004-2005, \$1,080,525.00 was transferred from the General Fund to the Building Fund. Consequently, since transfers from the General Fund to support other operations negatively impact public safety staffing, this subsidy has been reduced by \$685,381.00 for fiscal year 2006-2007. Two million dollars of CDBG monies will allow continuation of the City's aggressive demolition program; and, \$400,000 will allow for continued weed and trash abatement. CDBG monies will continue to be reallocated to these activities and, as often as possible, the work will be done "in house."

With regard to the Public Improvement Fund, funding has been requested for twenty-six police cars, and building improvements to the Municipal Center building structure and roof. After the audit, a reevaluation of the fund balance will assist in determining future capital purchases and prioritization of resources. An equitable balance must be made between the need for public safety vehicles, transportation equipment, and other capital improvements.

The Police Department budget has been increased by \$1,476,019.00. This increase does not include increases in wages, fringes and allowances; however, it does maintain the additional police officers that were added in fiscal year 2006, and includes new technology from "New World." By way of this new technology, police officers will be able to maintain a greater level of safety through advance knowledge pertaining to a given address or individual prior to going to the scene. With the recently settled police union contract, more patrol officers will be patrolling the streets daily. Additionally, integration of police and fire data used to track trends and crime patterns will be achieved through this advanced technology. The overall budget for the Police Department has been increased by \$2,523,973.00.

In my view, this proposed budget is both fiscally responsible and continues to deliver effective and dependable governmental operations. As the City continues to face the uncertainty of declining revenues and high unemployment, I remain committed to the removal of blight, the improvement of City streets and sidewalks, and leading the City in the direction of prosperity. Together my administration and I will continue to work tirelessly to provide the citizens of Flint quality services, responsible leadership, and management accountability.
