To Prospective Bidders:

Information disclosed and/or questions raised since issuing Bidding Documents require that changes in or interpretations of these Bidding Documents be made as noted below. This Addendum No. 3 forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original Bidding Documents dated May 2020. All provisions of the Bidding Documents, which are not so amended, remain in full force and effect.

CHANGE TO BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

1. Section 00400 included as part of Addendum No. 2, delete section and replace with Section 00400 BID FORM included as Enclosure No. 1 in Addendum No. 3.

CHANGES TO SPECIFICATIONS

1. Section 01230, page 3, SCHEDULE OF ALTERNATES, add as follows:

Alternate No. 3

Description: The Alternate consists of the deletion of the work to be performed for installation of Rectangular Butterfly Gate BG.100.1 in Battery A Primary Effluent channel. This includes installation of gate, walkway platform, and associated electrical and instrumentation work.

Reference Drawing No. S-105, D-003, 106, 308 and associated E and I sheets.

Alternate No. 4

Description: The Alternate consists of furnishing buttefly valve in lieu of DCV 200.1-5 and DCV 201.1-4 on aeration piping in galleries. The buttefly valves shall be High Performance Buttefly Style (Basis of design Dezurik BHP). Valve shall have stainless steel body with 316 stainless steel disc and shaft. The valve shall be suitable for modulating operation with motorized operator. Valve shall be furnished as part of Blower Manufacturer package and match requirements of DCV 200.1-5 and DCV 201.1-4 on Valve Schedule.

CHANGES TO DRAWINGS

- 1. Sheet G-002, Note 17, delete note and replace as follows:
 - 17. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR APPLYING FOR ALL FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL PERMITS AND CODE REVIEW. CONTRACTOR SHALL PAY FOR COST OF TOWNSHIP BUILDING, ELECTRICAL, AND MECHANICAL PERMITS. ENGINEER HAS COORDINATED WITH TWP BUILDING INSPECTOR AND THE BUILDING PERMIT COST IS \$34,000 AND SHALL BE PAID FOR BY CONTRACTOR.
- 2. Sheet S-101, Notes, add note as follows:
 - 3. EXISTING STEEL ANGLE FRAME SHALL BE REMOVED FROM PIPE CHASE BETWEEN PRIMARY INFLUENT AND AERATION EFFLUENT CHANNELS PRIOR TO FILLING CHASE WITH CONCRETE PER DETAIL C ON SHEET S-301.
- 3. Sheet D-108, BATTERY "B" TANK 1, add note as follows:
 - "PROPOSED DIFFUSER GRID NOT SHOWN IN PASS NO. 4 FOR CLARITY, SEE SECTION 11376 FOR DETAILS".
- 4. Sheet I-200, in lower level corner change note "ROSEMOUNT 8750 SERIES ..." to read as follows;
 - "ROSEMOUNT 8750 SERIES OR YOKOWAGA ADMAG SERIES. RATED FOR CONTINUOUS SUBMERGENCE. (TYP.)"

QUESTIONS RAISED DURING BIDDING

1. Can the vegetation growing in Battery B Tank 1, Pass 1 thru 4, be disposed of on the WPC site?

Answer: Yes, the material may be moved to a location onsite and disposed of as directed by WPC.

2. Is concrete repair allowance to be used to fix spalled concrete at expansion joints?

Answer: Yes, per Unit Price allowance table.

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3. Can the existing Effluent Water pipe located at the corner of the Equipment Building and Battery B gallery be temporarily removed to provided clearer access through gallery?

Answer: Yes, the pipe may be temporarily removed, CONTRACTOR shall reinstall and test piping after completion of removal work in Battery B gallery.
