160549 Amendment/Emergency Ordinance/Chapter 24 (Housing)/Article I (International Property Maintenance Code)/Section 24-4 (Adoption -Comprehensive Rental Inspection Code) An ordinance to amend Chapter 24 (Housing), Article I (International Property Maintenance Code), Section 24-4 (Adoption - Comprehensive Rental Inspection Code) of the Code of the City of Flint pursuant to Flint City Charter Section 3-306 (Emergency Ordinances), as an emergency affecting life, health and property exists in that rental properties in the city of Flint must be inspected in order to ensure that they are safe and fit for habitation by the residents of the city of Flint - and the City's Comprehensive Rental Inspection Code requires revision so that such inspections are mandatory.
