## Domestic & Sexual Violence Sexual Assault Kit Initiative (SAKI)

In FY2015, the City of Flint Police Department received a SAKI grant, as well as funding from the New York County District Attorney's Office, to fund two full-time police investigators to address the city's previously unsubmitted sexual assault kits (SAKs). The department has used its grant money to conduct an inventory of unsubmitted SAKs as well as to fund a prosecutor in the Genesee County Prosecutor's Office and a sexual assault advocate through the Young Women's Christian Association (YWCA) of Greater Flint.
