 - F. The public speaker will state and spell their name and be allowed 3 minutes for public speaking;
 - G. The speaker will be muted after the 3 minutes have expired;
 - H. After the public speakers have completed speaking, the Administrator will read all emailed public comments and public comments placed in the red drop box in front of City Hall.
2. The public may send public comments by email to ZBAPublicComment@cityofflint.com and/or place them in the red drop box located in front of City Hall at 1101 S. Saginaw St., Flint, MI 48502, no later than 30 minutes prior to the meeting start time of 5:30 p.m.
