1. As the factory authorized rep. for the state for Fairbanks could Kerr respond to items 3 & 4 only?

A. The City would consider a partial bid.

2. For pricing will you accept a specific scenario in which we replace a finite list of items and nothing more? Or my preference is we quote a firm number for an evaluation of the pump. The evaluation would come with a recommendation and firm price for the additional cost to complete recommended repairs.

A. Please Bid the finite list of items as this is just a bid list to determine who the lowest bidder is.

3. We would need to evaluate the listed sites to determine what we would need to do to adequately quote the projects. For example, are any confined space? Truck access?

A. When we use this service WPC staff pulls the pump and does the reinstallation - The contractor will not have to go into confined spaces. They just need to pick up, repair and return.

All other bidding terms, requirements, and conditions continue as indicated in the remaining original bid documents.

The Chief Buyer, Jarin McGee, is an officer for the City of Flint with respect to this RFP.
