MOWING AND TRIMMING SPECIFICATIONS City of Flint

1. Scope of work:

The Contractor shall provide all labor, equipment, materials, incidentals and other related materials required to completely and satisfactory groom, nurture, cultivate, sustain, care for and otherwise maintain the specified parkland and lawns provided by the Department of Parks & Recreation for the period 7/1/23 through 6/30/26. All services will be performed according to the highest industry standards for such services. All services will be performed on a predictable, regular basis without need for additional advice or planning. All non-routine work shall have prior approval from the Park & Forestry Supervisor as this work is generally done at an additional cost over and above the contracted prices. The City of Flint is requesting all vendors to submit a list of equipment that will be used to perform said services. Equipment must be available for immediate inspection after the opening of the bid.

2. Maintenance of Lawn Areas:

- a. Routine lawn mowing, trimming and edging are required to maintain a manicured, uniform, dense stand of turf during the entire mowing season.
- b. All mowing shall be done with clean, freshly sharpened and properly adjusted rotary mulching/recycling, or reel type mowing equipment.
- c. rimming around trees, fence edges, and other objects in the lawn area shall be performed when mowing occurs. Mow no closer than 12" to the trees and trimming around the trees shall be performed so that damage to the equipment and trees is avoided.
- d. Normal, everyday litter and debris shall be removed from lawns, by the contractor, **before** mowing begins. Parks & Forestry Division shall be contacted if large quantities of illegal dumped debris are present. If grass clippings left by mowing lay on top of grass and become unsightly when dried out, they shall be removed mechanically and taken from the site and disposed of in a legal manner. Clippings shall not be blown into streets.
- e. If the Contractor desires to use chemical herbicides for control of trimming area, any and all chemicals shall be approved in advanced by the Project Manger and performed in accordance with all applicable Local, State and Federal restrictions and guidelines for chemical application. The Contractor shall be held responsible for all violations. The Contractor shall submit Material Safety Data Sheets for chemicals.
- f. Clippings and related mowing and maintenance waste from all walks, ground cover beds, parking lots and drives shall be removed from the site before mowing is considered complete and before the Contractor leaves the job site. Contractor is responsible for proper disposal of waste.

3. Frequency of Mowing/Scheduling:

- a. Contractor shall be assigned properties and route to be maintained by the Parks & Forestry Supervisor or other designed City employee.
- b. Mowing and trimming shall occur on a 10-14 day cycle or scheduled as needed when the grass is approximately 3 ½ to 4 ½ inches tall. The first mowing shall occur as season conditions indicate or when the Project Manager indicates. The final mowing shall occur at the end of the fall growing season as determined by a stop in growth of the leaf blades, or as directed by the Supervisor.
- c. Grass shall be cut at a height of 2 to 2 ½ inches. Not more than one-third to one half of the height of the grass shall be removed in any single cutting.
- d. City Hall and the Fire Stations are to be mowed weekly.

The City of Flint does have the right to inspect equipment before the contract is executed.
