SUBJECT: **Addendum #01** – B24-001 – Lab Waste Disposal – 3 years REBID

This addendum has been published to address the following:

- Question: Can you provide any representative examples of materials/chemicals designated for each category noted in the Bid Spec Lab Disposal service chart?  
• **Answer: Hydrochloric Acid (Acids); Sodium Hydroxide (Caustics); 2-Propanol (Flammables); Ammonia (Poisonous [i.e. Toxic]); Peroxides (Reactives); Ammonium Persulfate (Oxidizers); Diatomaceous Earth (Non-regulated); and Mercury compounds (Mercury).**
- Question: Do you provide your own containers for packaging chemicals or do you want this included in the total price per unit?  
• **Answer: Include in the price. We do not have our own containers.**
- Question: Is the material from one location or multiple?  
• **Answer: From one (1) location - City of Flint Water Pollution Control Facility.**
- Question: Is there any overall idea of anticipated volumes for each category of characteristic disposal?  
• **Answer: Volumes generated will be less than 100 kg (220 lbs) of hazardous waste and less than 1 kg (2.2 lbs) of acute hazardous waste per month. Categorized as a Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG).**
- Question: Is there an anticipated number of pickups required within a scheduled year?  
• **Answer: Likely one, though on demand, there could be an additional one or two.**
- Question: Will there be any emergency response needed and if so, what is the response time?  
• **Answer: In the event of a hazardous spill, there could be an emergency response. Though I don't anticipate that. The response time for a spill would be dependent on the spill type, though the cleanup would need to be as fast as possible.**
- Question: Will bonds be required?  
• **Answer: No.**



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All other bidding terms, requirements, and conditions continue as indicated in the remaining original bid documents.
