The Purchasing Manager, Lauren Rowley, is an officer for the City of Flint with respect to this RFP.





Bassett Park: approximately 850 feet, remove existing bollards around parking lot.



Broome Park: approximately 5200 feet, remove existing fence on Norbert. Updated from SOW to not include bollards along Hammerberg and Lincoln Ave. Also, it has been decided to remove the fence along Neubert completely and only have bollards to ensure uniformity and security within the park.



Clara Hilborn Park: approximately 2300 feet, remove existing bollards along MLK and around the parking lot.



Delaware Park: approximately 550 feet




Dort Park: Approximately 450 feet



Iroquois: Approximately 1100 feet




Polk Park: Approximately 480 feet
