[NOTE: Mr. Edwards will replace Beverly Walker-Griffea.]

250082-T Reallocation of ARPA Funds/Flint Freedom Schools Collaborative

Resolution resolving that the appropriate City Officials are authorized to do all things necessary, including executing any necessary agreements, to appropriate funding from the funding source account #101-612.008-801.000 to Flint Freedom Schools Collaborative in the amount of \$40,000.00. [NOTE: The goal of this project is to engage K-12 grade scholars in a multicultural Integrated Reading Curriculum that supports them and their families through five essential components: High-quality academic enrichment; Parent and family development; Civic engagement and social action; Intergenerational servant leadership development; and Nutrition; health, and mental health.]

250084-T Reallocation of ARPA Funds/Flint Affiliation

Resolution resolving that the appropriate City Officials are authorized to do all things necessary, including executing any necessary agreements, to appropriate funding from the funding source account #101-612.008-801.000 to Flint Affiliation in the amount of \$47,000.00. [NOTE: Flint Affiliation is a Flint based AAU Basketball / mentoring program Founded over three decades ago (1992). The goal of Flint Affiliation is to provide a safe space for young men to learn life skills, responsibility, disciple and accountability.]

250085-T Reallocation of ARPA Funds/Youth Arts Unlocked

Resolution resolving that the appropriate City Officials are authorized to do all things necessary, including executing any necessary agreements, to appropriate funding from the funding source account #101-612.008-801.000 to Youth Arts Unlocked in the amount of \$50,000.00. [NOTE: Youth Arts: Unlocked's (YAU) mission is twofold: to bring visual and performing arts to detained and court-involved youth in Flint and to bring their work to the public.]

250086-T Reallocation of ARPA Funds/Motherly Intercession

Resolution resolving that the appropriate City Officials are authorized to do all things necessary, including executing any necessary agreements, to appropriate funding from the funding source account #101-612.008-801.000 to Motherly Intercession in the amount of \$50,000.00. [NOTE: Motherly Intercession's mission is to empower children and foster a stronger community by preventing the cycle of intergenerational incarceration.]

250088-T CO#1/William E Walter/HVAC Services/Maintenance Division

Resolution resolving that the Proper City Officials are hereby authorized to enter into change order #1 to contract with William E. Walter, Inc. for additional HVAC services, in the amount of \$75,000.00 and a revised aggregate amount of \$646,761.00.

250089-T Truck & Trailer Specialties, Inc./Purchase Four (4) 1 Ton Dump Truck Beds/Water Department/Utilities Division

Resolution resolving that Division of Purchases and Supplies, upon City Council's approval, is hereby authorized to issue a Purchase Order to Truck & Trailer Specialties, Inc. for the purchase of four (4) 1-ton dump truck beds in an amount NOT-TO-EXCEED \$96,744.00 for FY25 (07/01/24-06/30/2025). [NOTE: These beds will replace the worn-out beds on these vehicles which are otherwise in very good condition with low mileage.]

250090-T CO#1/Weinstein Electric Co./Additional Electrical Services/Maintenance Division

Resolution resolving that upon City Council's approval, that the Proper City Officials are hereby authorized to enter into change order #1 to the contract with Weinstein Electric Co. for additional electrical services, in the amount of \$184,248.00 and a revised aggregate amount of \$448,248.00. Based on review and validation of the appropriate fund use by the City's compliance firm, implementation of the ARPA funds will be consistent and compliant with US Department of Treasury's requirements and previously approved authorizations.

250091-T CO#1/Detroit Salt, Inc./Additional Bulk Salt/Street Maintenance Division

Resolution resolving that the Division of Purchases & Supplies, upon City Council's approval, is hereby authorized to issue change order #1 to the purchase order with Detroit Salt, Inc. for additional bulk salt, in the amount NOT-TO-EXCEED \$200,000.00 and a revised aggregate amount of \$500,000.00.

250092-T CO#5/Trio Paint/General Contractor Services

Resolution resolving that the proper City Officials, upon City Council approval, are hereby authorized to enter into change order #5 to the contract with Trio Paint for renovations /updates in multiple areas of the City Hall complex, in an amount NOT-TO-EXCEED \$202,112.00 and a revised three year aggregate total of \$1,267,252.43.

250097-T Reallocation of ARPA Funds/Water Rate Stabilization Fund

Resolution resolving that due to [water rate increases to the City of Flint by the Great Lakes Water Authority] and the economic hardship due to COVID-19, that the appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things necessary, including executing any necessary agreements, to appropriate funding from the funding source account #101-000.000-995.591 to the Water Rate Stabilization Fund, in the amount of \$2,000,000. [NOTE: City of Flint residents have not received a water rate increase since 2015. The Great Lakes Water

Authority increases their rates to the City of Flint annually, and the upcoming fiscal years increase is set at 5.9%. In order for the City of Flint to not pass this increase onto its residents a water rate stabilization fund is necessary.]

250100-T Reallocation of ARPA Funds/Youth Job Training/City of Flint Second Clean & Safe Summer Program

Resolution resolving that the appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things necessary, including executing any necessary agreements, to appropriate funding from the funding source account 101-728.018-801.000 to City of Flint Second Clean & Safe Summer Youth Job Training Program in the amount of \$225,000. Based on review and validation of the appropriate fund use by the City's compliance firm, implementation of these funds will be consistent and compliant with US Department of Treasury requirements and previously approved authorizations. [NOTE: The City Administration recommends reallocating \$225,000 of ARPA funds, previously obligated for revenue replacement, to provide funding to City of Flint Clean & Safe Summer Youth Job Training Program to provide a second round of summer jobs for youth ages 15-19 to eradicate the negative use of idle time and to keep them safe from crime. The program offers six (6) weeks of summer employment paid through the ARPA Youth Job Training category and for 5-7 non-profit organizations to serve as host sites.]

250107-T AIS Construction Equipment/Repairs to a Paver/DPW/Street Maintenance

Resolution resolving that the Division of Purchases and Supplies, upon City Council's approval, is hereby authorized to issue a purchase order to AIS Construction Equipment for replacement of parts on a paver, in an amount NOT-TO-EXCEED \$91,907.57. [NOTE: The paver that is used to pave local streets was purchased in 2018 as a used demo (2016 model) and needs several repairs. This is a two-track paver, and both tracks need to be replaced this year because they are worn out. There is also a screed under the unit that needs to be replaced. This screed finishes the surface of the asphalt, that's what makes the road nice and smooth. If these replacements are not made, local roads will not be able to be paved this year. This paver is used continuously during the construction season and doing these replacements will extend the life of the paver since a new paver costs several million dollars. AIS Construction Equipment is the authorized dealer for the Vogele brand in this area.]

250108-T Global Solutions Group, Inc./WPC Surveillance Improvements

Resolution resolving that the Proper City Officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to issue a Purchase Order to Global Solutions Group, Inc., 25900 Greenfield Road,

Drive, Suite 220, Oak Park, MI 48237 for Water Pollution Control Surveillance System Improvements, in the NOT-TO-EXCEED FY 2025 amount of \$153,123.03. [NOTE: Water Pollution Control has a security surveillance system which is antiquated, analog, and failing. An improvement to this system is imperative in order to monitor the Water Pollution Control Facilities, entrances/exits, and other activities that will ensure that premises are secure.]

250109-T AIS Construction Equipment/Purchase New Wirtgen W50 RI Cold Milling Machine/DPW/Street Maintenance

Resolution resolving that the Division of Purchases and Supplies, upon City Council's approval, is hereby authorized to issue a purchase order to AIS Construction Equipment for the purchase of a new Wirtgen W50 RI cold milling machine in an amount NOT-TO-EXCEED \$310,543.61. [NOTE: The Street Maintenance division owns a cold milling machine, but it is very old (bought in 2006) and needs to be replaced. The City received a quote for a 2024 Wirtgen W50 cold milling machine, which will save some money over the 2025 models but will have the same warranties.]

250110-T Reallocation of ARPA Funds/Consumers Energy/Citywide Streetlight Upgrade/Energy-Efficient LED Bulbs/Reduce Utility Costs

Resolution resolving that the appropriate City Officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary including budget adjustments to enter into contract with Consumers Energy, to complete the replacement of streetlights throughout the city of Flint, for a total contract NOT-TO-EXCEED \$2,800,000.00. [NOTE: City Administration recommends allocating \$2,800,000 in ARPA funds for a contract with Consumers Energy to replace over 3,000 streetlight bulbs across the city with energy-efficient LED bulbs. This upgrade will enhance the effectiveness of the city's existing grid, improving public safety while also reducing monthly utility costs. The savings generated can be reinvested in installing new streetlights, particularly in high-crime areas identified through data from the Flint Police Department.]

250111.1-T Amended/Rehmann Robson, LLC/Additional Outstanding Charges/City of Flint's FY2023 Audit

Resolution resolving that the appropriate City Officials are authorized to do all things necessary to make payment to Rehmann Robson, LLC for additional outstanding charges for auditing services rendered for the City of Flint's FY2022-2023 Audit, in the amount of \$104,000.00, for a revised total contract amount of \$401,500.00. Funds will come from the General Fund Balance Line Item. [NOTE: Rehmann Robson, LLC has presented the City of Flint with an additional invoice for professional services rendered for the FY2023 Audit, due

to "significant delays due to errors in the City's initial accounting record and reconciliations", with approximately 820 additional auditing hours being expended by Rehmann in order to address these issues.] [NOTE: this resolution was amended to reflect a Final Progress Billing on the City's June 30, 2023, year-end audit, in the amount of \$29,000.00.]

250118-T Charitable Gaming License/Uncle Phil's Adventures in Philanthropy

Resolution resolving that Uncle Phil's Adventures in Philanthropy is recognized as a non-profit organization operating in the city of Flint for the purpose of obtaining charitable gaming licenses, as issued by the State of Michigan, Bureau of State Lottery, Charitable Gaming Division, relative to conducting charity and fundraising events, as allowed by Act 382 of Public Acts of 1972, as amended.
