Resolution resolving that the Flint City Council approves the issuance of a public notice requesting comments or objections to proposed modifications to the City of Flint's Sewer Use Ordinance for the Industrial Pretreatment Program, along with the related publication of the proposed modifications. [NOTE: The City of Flint has submitted proposed modifications to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) regarding the City's Sewer Use Ordinance and its previously approved and currently implemented Industrial Pretreatment Program as found in the City's Code of Ordinances, Chapter 46, Utilities. EGLE has reviewed the City's request and determined that it is a substantial program modification as defined in the Code of Federal Regulations and the Mich Admin Code. This requires a joint public notice by the City of Flint in conjunction with EGLE.]
